At the exhibition, Furuya will show plenty of miniature copper plate prints as well as palm-size paintings.

Small creatures are cute. Like the Sylvanian Families, large things are cute when they are small. The word "kawaii" has the meaning of "precious" and "I want to be with them" as well as "cute" in terms of its form. After having a baby, I am facing my roots through raising a child. I used to be ashamed of the cuteness and small scale of the motifs of my works, but I grew up surrounded by such things in a happy-go-lucky way. Miffy, Sailor Moon and animistic sensibilities are at the bottom of my heart. I want to consider the origins of that cute art and depict it.
