Jun Shirasu : For You Blue July 6 - July 27, 2024

eitoeiko is pleased to present *For You Blue*, a solo exhibition by Jun Shirasu from 6 to 27 July. This will be the artist's fourth solo exhibition at our gallery in four years, since his first exhibition in 2010. Jun Shirasu was born in Tokyo in 1965 and moved to the UK after graduating from Musashino Art University. He studied azulejos (Portuguese tiles) under a Portuguese professor at the Slade School of Fine Art, University College London, where he studied printmaking. Encountering the decorative culture that has been produced uninterruptedly for 500 years since the 16th century, it has become a core form of expression for the artist, along with printmaking. At the exhibtion, unlike the large-scale murals that span multiple sheets, Shirasu has captured a daily narrative story and translate into the single tile like a tanka or haiku poem. Please take a moment to discover these simple and tasteful works, like the easy-going country blues written by George Harrison.
