The current show is titled 'Beside Suizokukangekijou' and consists of artwork by two artists. This exhibition indicates the relationship of art and social movements, by the activities of the outdoor theater group Suizokukangekijou, from the viewpoint of contemporary art.

The exhibition focuses on the artworks of two artists. Daijiro Chiba, who performed as an actor in "Naked: A Dream Boat in Anthropocene", in Hamura, 2021, which was broadcast on NHK TV document, shows his series of Gekiga drawings.
